CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS January 17th, 2024.

As per the notice in the Red Cloud Chief, the Mayor and the City Council held a special meeting on January 17th, 2024, at 7:00 p.m. in the conference room of the Community Center. Members present: Mayor Brown, Councilman Horne, Mahin, Daehling, Goebel, Attorney McCracken, Superintendent Thies and Clerk Schmitz.
