

CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

April 30th, 2026

As per the notice posted, the Mayor and the City Council met for a special meeting in the meeting room of the Community Center at 12:00 pm to discuss truck parking during the HWY 281/136 project. Members present: Mayor Horne, Councilman Hobbs, Daehling, Goebel, and Clerk Schmitz. Councilwoman Elliott was absent.

Mayor Horne called the meeting to order and ask those present to join the council in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance. He then stated the Open Meetings Act is posted on the west wall for public viewing.

The council was present to discuss the truck parking lot during this street project. Councilman Goebel made the motion to keep it truck parking on the east half and the rest be public parking for the businesses during the street project only, seconded by Hobbs. Motion carried.

Councilman Daehling made the motion to sell brick from the compost site by the ton for \$220.00 a ton, one ton minimum, seconded by Goebel. Motion carried.

Lastly, Clerk Schmitz informed the council that utilities bills will be late due to the computer server crashing at the city office and losing 5 months of data that has to be manually reentered.

As there was no further business to be had and done by the Mayor and City Council, Councilman Goebel made the motion and was seconded by Daehling to adjourn said meeting at 12:22 p.m. Motion carried.
