The C&D disposal area will only accept waste defined as construction and demolition debris.

(NDEQ Title 132 defines construction and demolition waste as follows): Construction and demolition waste shall mean waste which results from the demolition of buildings, roads or other structures, including, but not limited to, beneficial fill materials.

The C&D disposal WILL accept the following waste:

- -wood (including painted and treated wood)
- -wall coverings (including wallpaper, paneling and tile)
- -drywall
- -plaster
- -non-asbestos insulation
- -roofing shingles and other roof coverings
- -plumbing fixtures
- -glass
- -plastic
- -carpeting
- -electrical wiring
- -metals/pipe
- -concrete & bricks

The C&D disposal WILL NOT accept the following waste:

-asbestos waste

-drums

-special waste

-fuel tanks

-liquid waste

-batteries

-household waste

-industrial waste

-corrugated cardboard

-appliances

-tires

-furniture

-solid waste

-hazardous waste & waste that contains Polychlorinated Biphenyl (PCB), putrescible waste
