

The C&D disposal area will only accept waste defined as construction and demolition debris.

(NDEQ Title 132 defines construction and demolition waste as follows):
Construction and demolition waste shall mean waste which results from the demolition of buildings, roads or other structures, including, but not limited to, beneficial fill materials.

The C&D disposal WILL accept the following waste:

- wood (including painted and treated wood)
- wall coverings (including wallpaper, paneling and tile)
- drywall
- plaster
- non-asbestos insulation
- roofing shingles and other roof coverings
- plumbing fixtures
- glass
- plastic
- carpeting
- electrical wiring
- metals/pipe
- concrete & bricks

The C&D disposal WILL NOT accept the following waste:
